Protecting the washing and the machine

- Empty pockets.
- Remove metal parts (paper clips, etc.).
- Wash delicates in the net/bag (tights, curtains, underwired bras).
- Close zips, button up covers.
- Brush sand out of pockets and collars.
- Remove curtain fittings or include in the net/bag.



Before washing for the first time

Do not put any washing in the washing machine! Turn on the tap, fill approx.1 litre of water and then pour ½ measuring cup of detergent into dispenser II. Set programme selector to Easy-Care 60 °C and select Start/Pause .

At the end of the programme set the programme selector to **Off.**

Soakina Load washing of the same colour

Pour soaking agent/detergent into dispenser II according to the manufacturer's instructions. Set programme selector to Cottons 30 °C and select Start/Pause ◆. After approx. 10 minutes select Start/Pause . After the required soaking time reselect Start/Pause . if the programme is to be continued or change the programme.



Starching Washing should not be treated with fabric softener

Liquid starch can be used in all wash programmes. Meter starch into the fabric softener dispenser & according to manufacturer's specifications.

Dyeing/Bleaching

Dve in small quantities only. Salt can corrode stainless steel. Observe the dve manufacturer's specification.

Do **not** bleach laundry in the washing machine.



Freshen up Use programme Rinse/Freshen Up

For items, that have been tucked away or stored for a period of time, to remove creases caused by folding and storage and to eliminate odours. Use fabric conditioner for "fresh" smell.



Protection of the environment/conservation tips

- Utilise the maximum amount of washing for the particular programme.
- Wash normally soiled washing without prewash.
- Instead of Cottons 90 °C select Cottons Eco 60 °C programme. Comparable cleaning result with significantly lower energy consumption.
- Meter detergent according to the manufacturer's instructions and water hardness.
- If the washing is then dried in the tumble driver, select spin speed according to the instructions of the dryer manufacturer.

If textiles are heavily soiled, reduce the load or select additional functions, e.g. **Intensive** Togrammes without prewash – pour detergent into dispenser **II**, programmes with prewash – divide detergent between dispensers I and **II**.

Regardless of the type of washing, **Easy-Care 40°C** with maximum spin speed is the best short programme for the inhomore.



Descale according to the instructions of the descaling agent-manufacturer, not required for correct detergent dosage.



Detergent-solution pump

Set programme selector to **Off**, pull out the mains plug.

For models without drainage hose:

Repeat steps until all the detergent solution has run out.

- Carefully unscrew the pump cover (residual water).
- 4. Clean the interior, pump cover thread and pump housing (fan impeller in the detergent-solution pump must rotate).
 - Reinsert and screw on pump cover.
- Insert and close service flap.
- To prevent unused detergent from flowing into the outlet during the next wash: Pour 1 litre of water into dispenser II and select the **Drain** by programme.

Drainage hose at the siphon

Set programme selector to Off, pull out the mains plug.

- 1. Loosen the hose clamp, carefully remove the drainage hose (residual water).
- 2. Clean the drainage hose and siphon connecting piece.
- 3. Reattach the drainage hose and secure the connection with the hose clamp.

Filters in the water supply

Release water pressure in the supply hose:

- 1. Turn off the tap!
- 2. Select any programme (except Spin @/Drain \u).
- 3. Press Start/Pause ①. Leave programme for approx. 40 seconds.
- 4. Set programme selector to Off.
- 5. Remove hose from tap.
- 6. Clean filter with small brush.
- 7. Depending on the model, remove hose from the rear of the appliance and clean the filter.
- Connect the hose and check for leaks.
