This appliance is top-heavy and must be secured to prevent the possibility of tipping forward.
To ensure that the appliance is stable under all loading conditions, the anti-tip bracket and fittings supplied must be installed according to the following installation steps by a professional installer.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

BEFORE INSTALLATION

- The appliance has front and rear rollers for moving the appliance forward and backward. Do not move the appliance sideways to avoid damaging the rollers or the floor covering/surface.
- Ensure your appliance is not exposed to any heat generating appliance eg cooktop, oven or dishwasher.
- The appliance must be installed by a qualified installer, or Fisher & Paykel trained and supported service technician to avoid faulty electrical connection.
- All connections for electrical power and earthing must comply with local codes and ordinances and be made by licensed personnel when required.
- Avoid installation of the appliance/s under a ground fault circuit interrupter (GFCI).
- Ensure the appliance is installed properly. Improper installation that results in appliance failure is not covered under the appliance warranty.

UNPACKING

- The appliance is heavy (including packaging — 302lb/137kg) and requires at least two persons to move and install. Avoid scratching the surface of your appliance when moving or installing.
- Keep the appliance stable and door closed to prevent tipping over when moving to installation location.
- Ensure feet of the appliance are retracted before moving to installation location.
- If appliance is damaged, contact your Fisher & Paykel dealer.
- Check all components and accessories are complete. Refer to 'Components' page.
- Record the model and registration numbers for future servicing or repair of your appliance.

ELECTRICAL

- Electrical connection for these appliances must be located in an adjacent area or unit (cabinet or cupboard) that is easily accessible in case of repair or disconnection.
- Once installed, the service technician will NOT remove the appliance from the cavity to gain access for repair.

WARNING!

- Electric shock hazard! Assume all parts live.
- Disconnect supply before servicing and installation.

SAFETY AND WARNINGS

INSTALLATION

Cavity preparation

- The anti-tip bracket and fittings supplied must be fitted to the wall of the finished enclosure to withstand a 225lb/100kg load.
- Ensure that the anti-tip bracket is installed correctly to prevent the possibility of the appliance tipping forward when the door is open.

Positioning inside the cabinetry

- DO NOT attempt to open the door until the appliance is fully installed.
- Ensure the door of the appliance is closed when rolling into the cabinetry.
- Ensure the power cord is not run over or damaged when rolling the product into the cabinetry.

Aligning inside the cabinetry

- Ensure the doors are in line with the cabinetry front and the appliance is centred.
- All four corners of the appliance must be supported firmly onto the floor to eliminate any movement. Installing the appliance on a soft, uneven, or not level floor may cause twisting and poor door sealing.

Fixing inside the cabinetry

- Use low speed, low torque setting when using a powered driver for the screws when fixing or aligning the product.
- Make sure to remove the depth alignment brackets before fixing the appliance inside the cabinetry.
- Open the appliance door to remove the alignment brackets from both sides of the appliance, and then re-tighten the screws.

Door panel installation

Stainless steel

- Protect the finish of the Fisher & Paykel Stainless Steel door panels from any scratch or damage.
- Leave the protective film on the panels when hanging and remove the film only when the installation is complete.

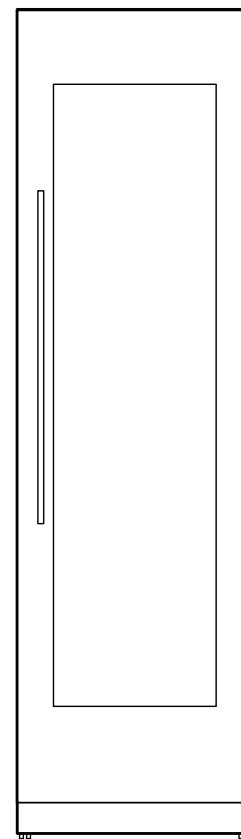
Custom

- If using Custom door panels, ensure they are prepared as per 'Custom door panel dimensions' section.
- Ensure the screw pilot holes do not penetrate the full depth of the panel.
- Do not place the handle holes in marked areas to avoid clashing with panel attachment brackets.
- Minimum panel thickness where screw hole is drilled must be 16mm.

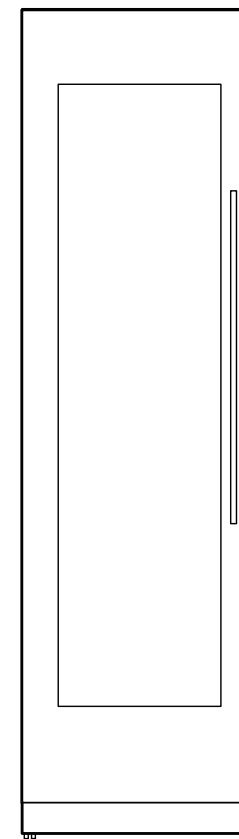
Door hinge change

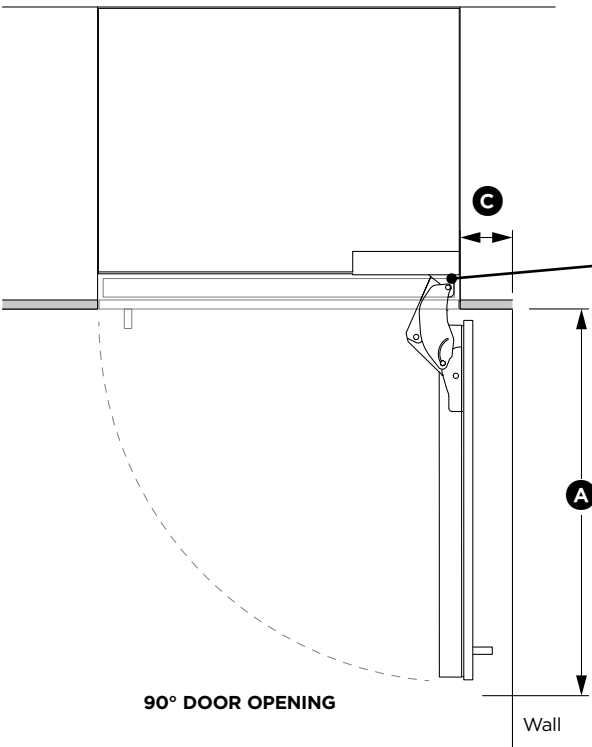
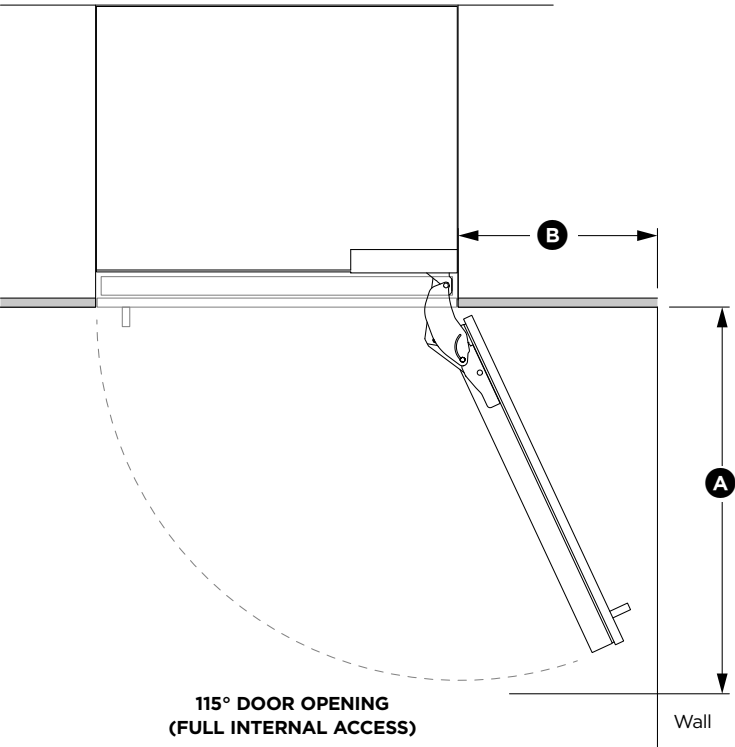
- The thickness of the custom door panel can vary as long as the screws do not penetrate beyond the full depth of the door panel, and as long as the overall weight of the panel does not exceed 55lb/25kg.
- Measurements of screw hole locations can vary depending on the height of toe kick 2-6"/50-152mm.

Check the cabinetry

- Check the dimensions of the cabinetry: height, width, depth, floor level, finished alcove returns.

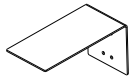
Check the power supply connection

- Ensure that there is a separate power socket for each appliance.
- Avoid sharing the power point with other appliances to prevent accidental switching off of the appliance.
- For power requirements, refer to the information on the serial plate.
- Ensure your appliance is properly grounded (earthed).
- Connect your appliance to an electrical supply with the fitted plug and lead.
- If power connection is located behind the appliance, we recommend to install an isolating switch to a location that is easily accessible to the user for repair or disconnection.
- Follow local codes and ordinances when installing the appliance.

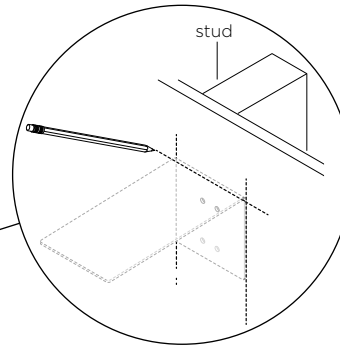
Safety glasses

- 1 Measure height from floor to alcove return (A). Use this measurement to locate the attachment height (B) of anti-tip bracket to the back wall.

- Attachment height of anti-tip bracket should not be more than 2138mm to ensure the appliance is prevented from tipping over during installation.

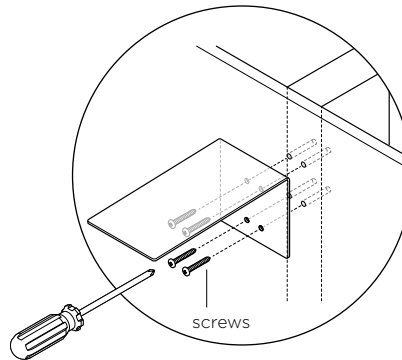


- 2 Mark a horizontal line on the back wall based on measured attachment height. Ensure there is a stud behind the wall.

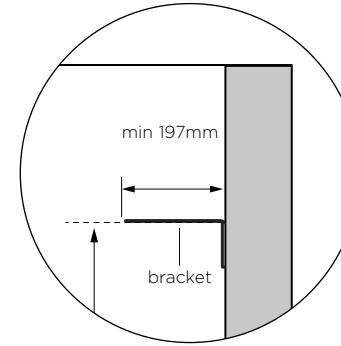


For plaster board wall installation

- 5 Fix bracket to wall with 10x40mm cross head screws (4x), and screw tightly with a screwdriver.

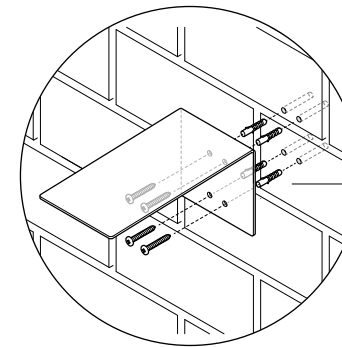


- 3 Place the bracket to the backwall. Align the undersurface of bracket along the marked line.

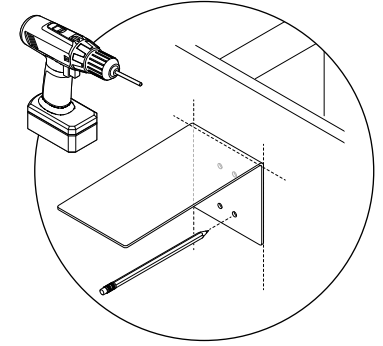


For solid wall installation

- 6 Hammer 10x30mm masonry plugs into wall until flush. Fix bracket to wall with 10x40mm cross head screws (4x), and screw tightly.

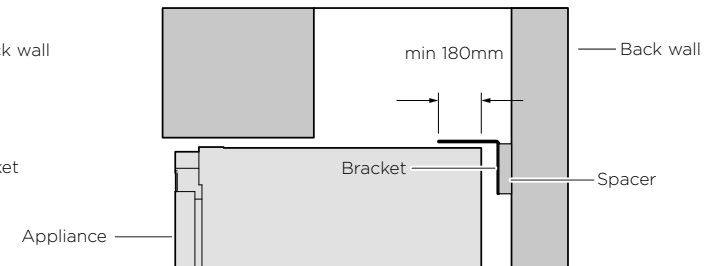
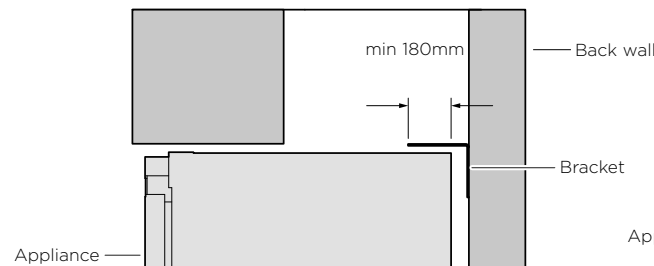


- 4 Mark screw hole locations, and drill screw holes with powered drill.

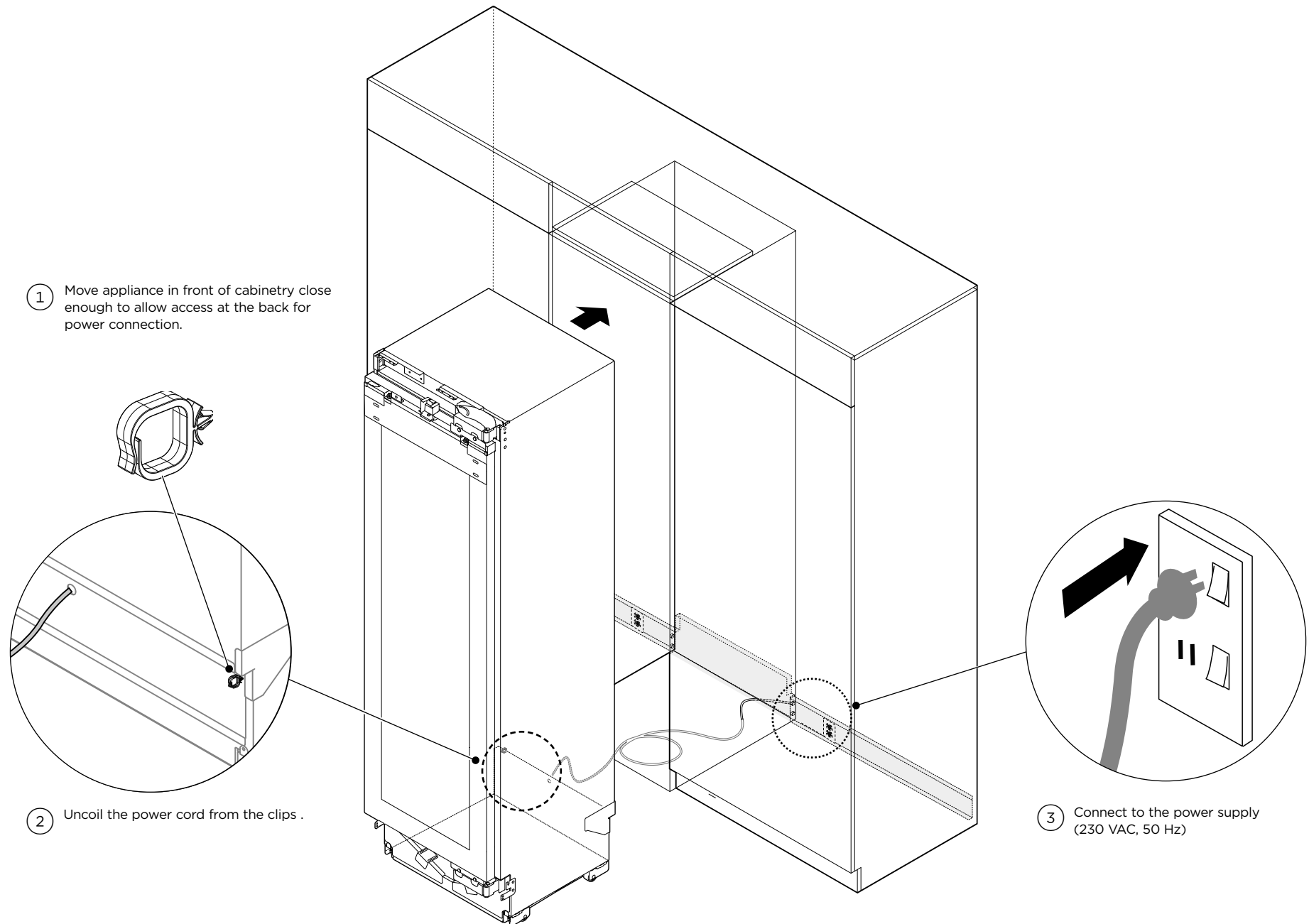


IMPORTANT!

Ensure the bracket overlaps the appliance by a minimum 7 1/16" (min 180mm) for a secure hold. If the minimum 7 1/16" (180mm) overlap cannot be achieved, install a solid spacer to the wall screw behind the bracket.

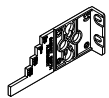

- ② Locate alignment gauges to screws at correct orientation.



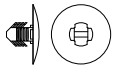
- ③ Attach alignment gauge so that screw head passes through the keyhole.



- ④ Push gauge down to lock screw position in keyhole, and tighten the screw just enough to firmly hold the gauge.

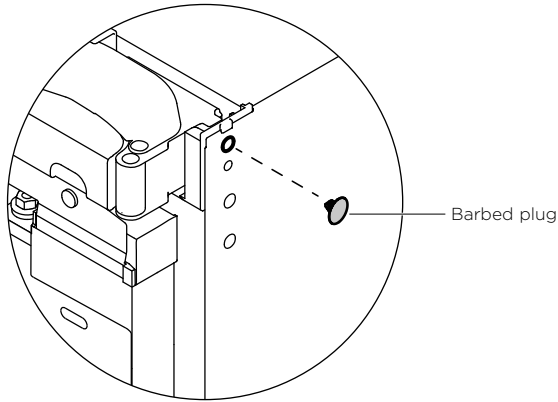

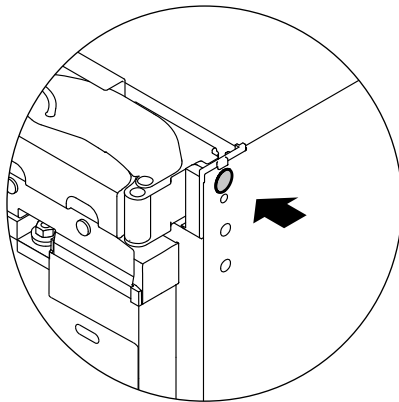

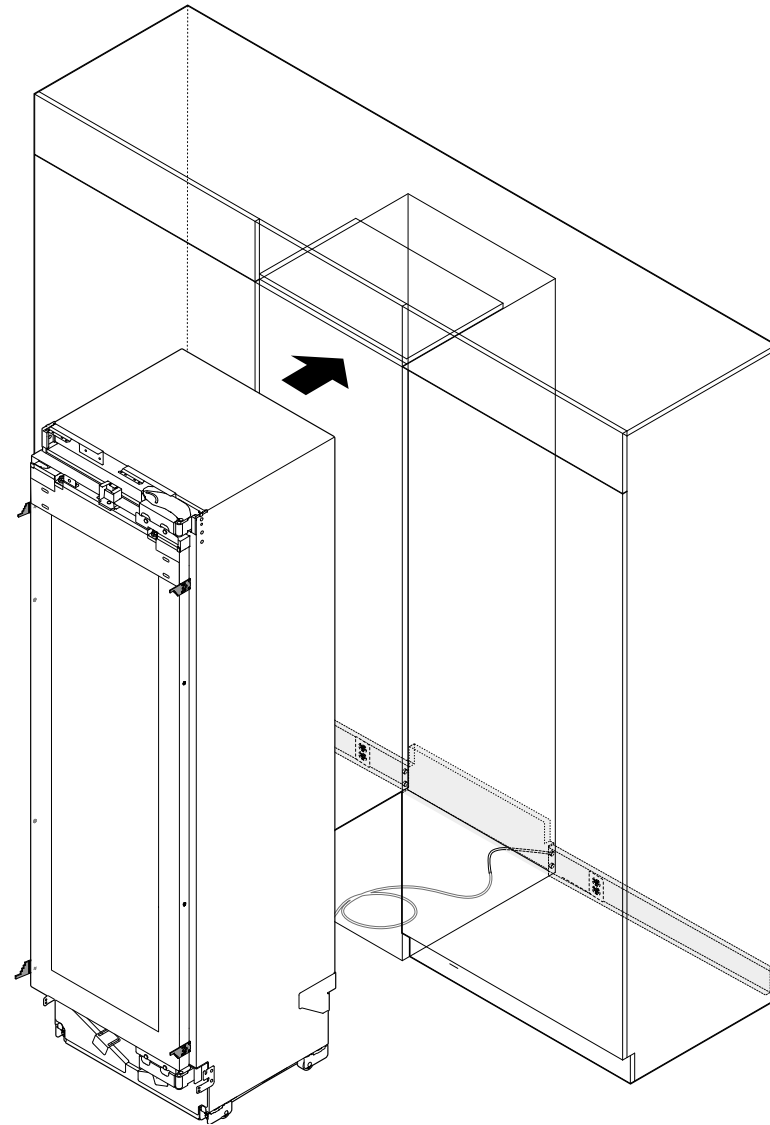
- Check clearance between floor and feet. Rollers must roll freely on the floor.
- Be careful not to run over the power cord when rolling in the appliance.



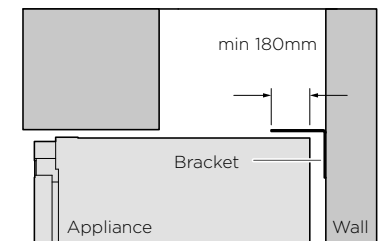
- ① Before rolling into the cavity, insert barbed plugs into large holes on the top right and left sides of the appliance.



- ② The plugs protect the inside surface of cabinetry from being damaged by screws when pushing in the appliance.

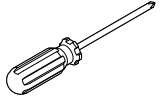


- ③ Roll appliance slowly into the cabinetry until the anti tip bracket overlaps the back top surface of appliance by minimum 180mm.

- 1 Mark the step of depth gauge on each side of the door based on the thickness of door panel.



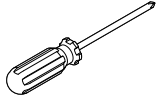
- 2 Move the appliance to align the marked steps of gauges to be flush with front surface of adjacent cabinetry. Use a ruler to check if gauges are in line relative to thickness of door panel.



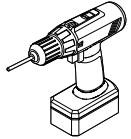
- 3 Check if the gaps between appliance and cabinetry side walls are even on both sides.

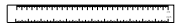

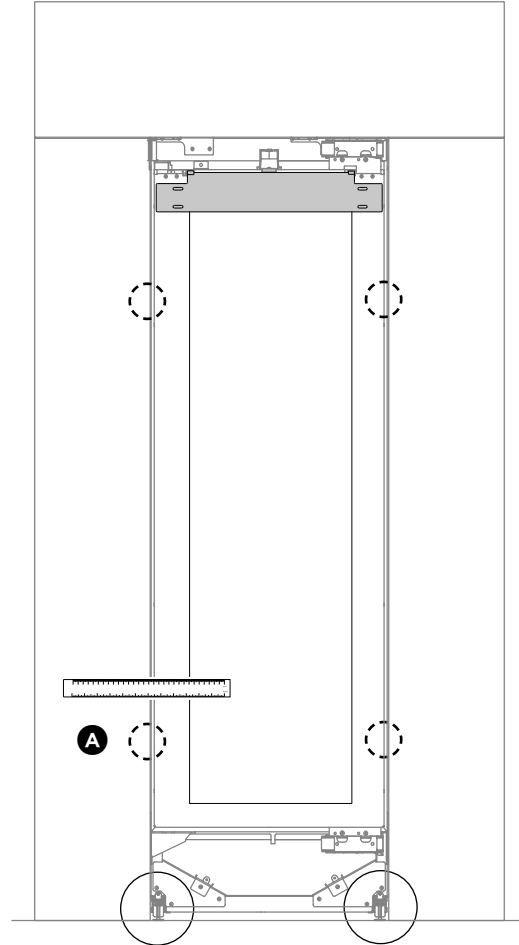

Adjusting appliance inside the cabinetry

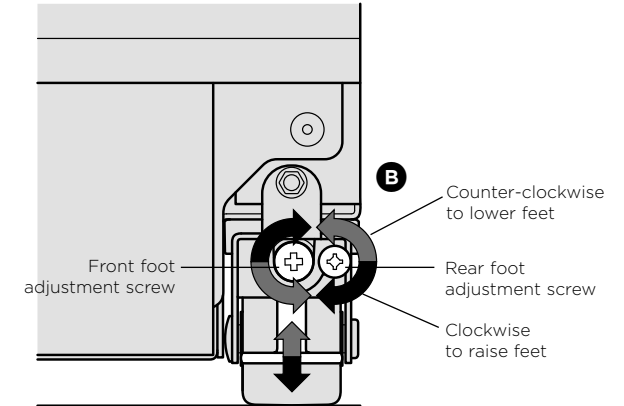
- 1 Centre the appliance within the alcove using the adjacent cabinetry walls as guide.

- 2 Check gaps top and bottom, left and right using a ruler. (A)

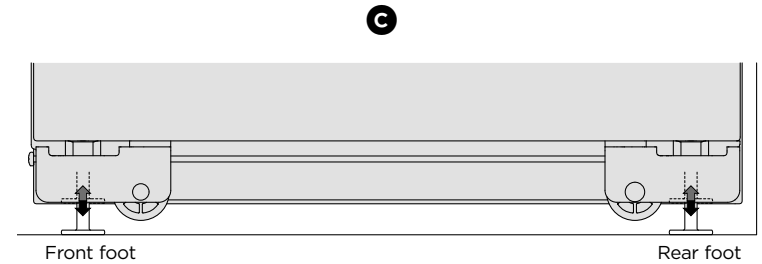


IMPORTANT!

- Turn front and rear adjustment screws clockwise to raise height of appliance and counter-clockwise to lower height.
- One turn of adjustment screw is equal to 0.5mm height adjustment.
- Use a cross-head screwdriver to turn the screws. If using a powered driver, use low torque setting.



- 3 Turn front and rear adjustment screws clockwise to extend the feet until it engages the floor, and top bracket reaches ceiling of alcove. (B)



- 4 Turn adjustment screws alternately until you achieve correct alignment. Check alignment gauges while adjusting the screws to maintain alignment of the appliance. (C)

Check top and bottom, left and right gaps again.

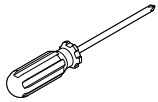

③ Insert carbon filter in hatch.



④ Push the filter gently into the hatch until flush, and then close the cover until it locks to the latch.

- Ensure the cover is completely closed to prevent hatch or filter from being damaged.

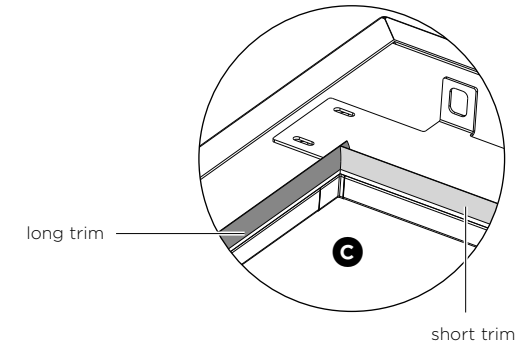
- 1 Place the short trim along the length of the top of door panel cutout to determine the correct length between long trims. **(A)**



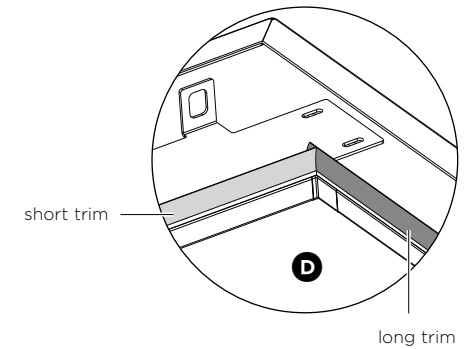
- 2 Cut both ends of the short trim to length. **(B)**
- 3 Peel off a small portion of red protective film from the short edge.



- 4 Attach the peeled portion starting from one end of flange perpendicular to top end of long trim **(D)**.



- 5 Continue attaching the short trim for the length of the top of door panel cutout, peeling off the film as you go. Ensure the trim is aligned flush to inside edge of flange.

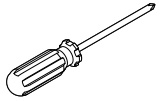


- 6 Attach the remaining peeled portion of short trim to the flange perpendicular to top end of the other long trim. **(D)**

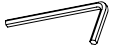

1 Height adjustment

Turn Adjustment screw to raise or lower the height of door panel relative to door. Continue adjustment until gap with cabinetry is more than 3mm.

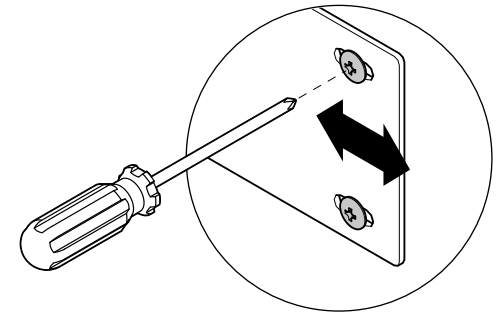


2 Depth adjustment

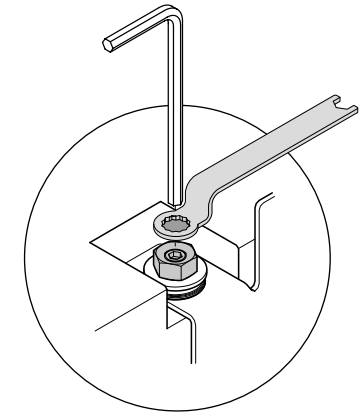
Loosen side screws on both sides of door, and slide door panel forward/backward. Re-tighten once satisfied.

IMPORTANT!

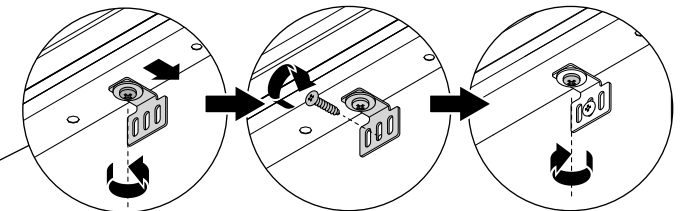
Check gaps 1/8" (3mm) between door panel/cabinetry using depth gauge. All door panels have full axis adjustment to ensure flushness with adjacent walls.



- 3 To adjust door panel further, remove door panel then loosen the fixing screws of hanging bracket and move the bracket sideways to suit.



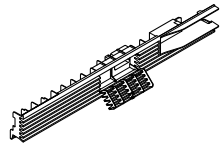
- 4 Once satisfied with door panel position, fully tighten M8 washer and nut to adjustment screw.



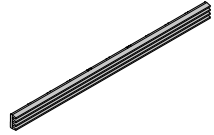
- 5 Loosen screw at bottom of door, and slide locking bracket until it touches the panel. Fix the locking bracket to door panel with 8Gx16 countersunk screw.

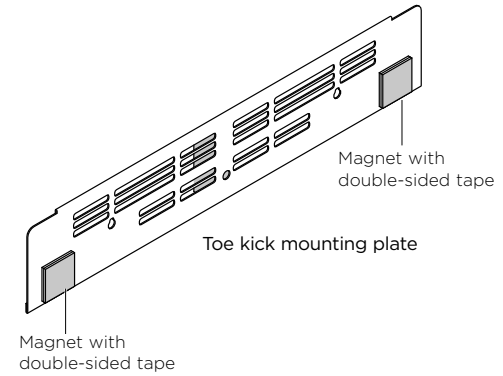


- ① Loosen cap screws of adjustment brackets on both sides of plinth with a hex key.

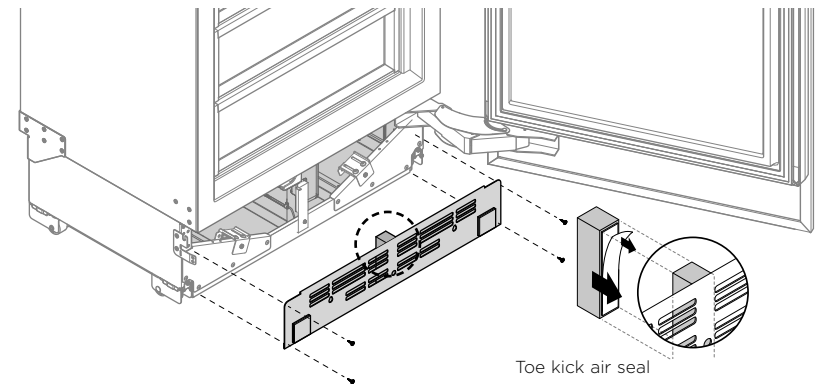


- ② Adjust the toe kick to the desired depth by moving it forward/backward. Re-tighten cap screws once satisfied.

Installing toe kick mounting plate



- ③ Reinstall toe kick mounting plate to plinth using same screws set aside previously.
NOTE: If toe kick depth is less than 92mm, attach an air toe kick seal to the mounting plate.
- Peel off the adhesive tape of air toe kick seal and attach to middle of back side of mounting plate. (A)



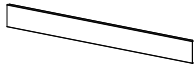

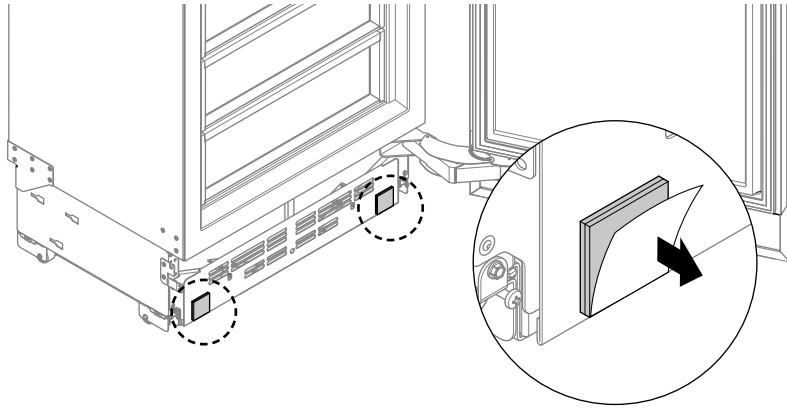

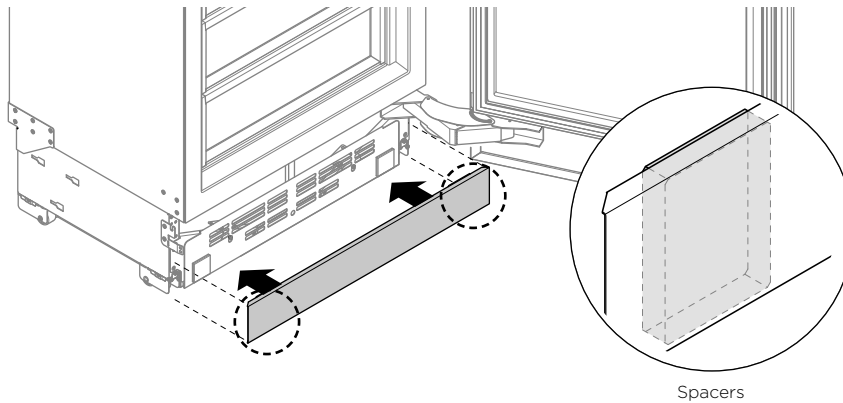


Toe kick

Installing toe kick



- 1 Peel off the adhesive tape backing of the magnets.

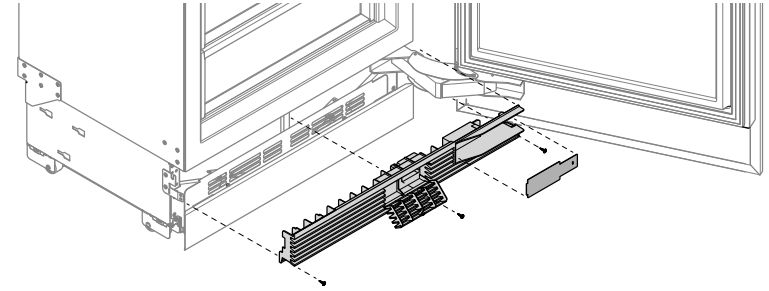


- 2 Position toe kick in front of mounting plate, with spacers on toe kick aligned with magnets of mounting plate. Press toe kick onto mounting plate to fix the position.

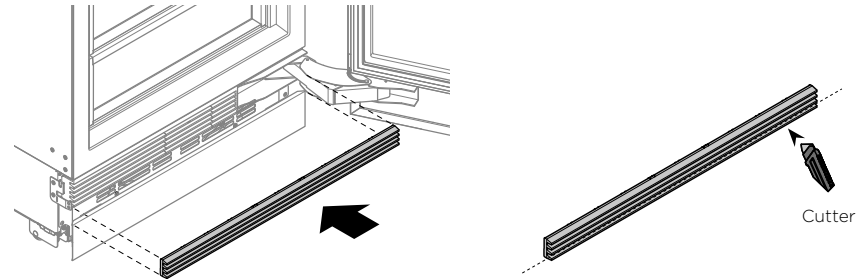
IMPORTANT!

- For custom toe kick, spacers are not needed.
- For correct dimensions of toe kick, refer to 'Toe kick panel dimensions' for more information.

Attaching top and bottom grilles

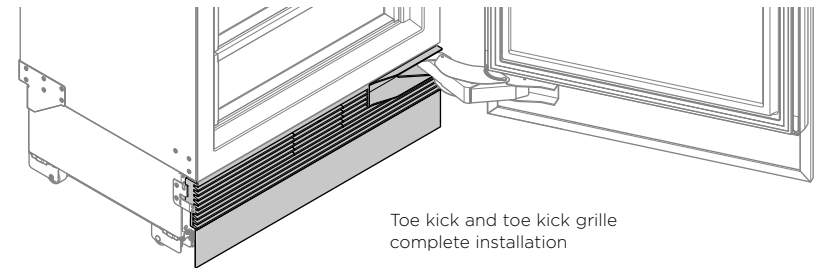


- 3 Reinstall top grille using same screws set aside previously, and reattach cover to bottom hinge pocket.



- 4 Reinstall the bottom grille to the mounting plate.

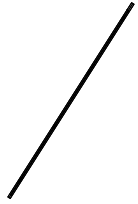
NOTE: For toe kick heights 114-127mm, shorten the bottom grille by cutting along the vertical ribs.

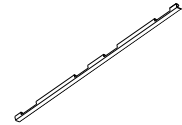

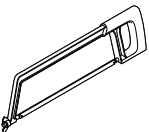

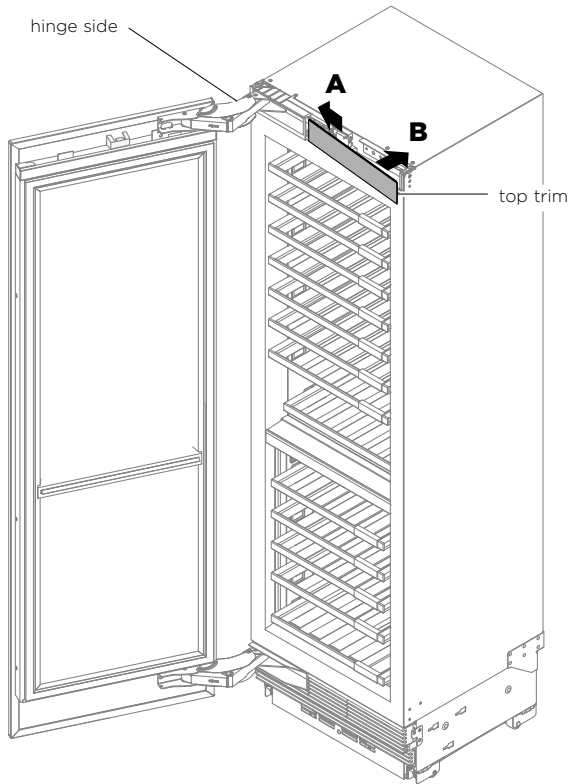

Re-installing top trim



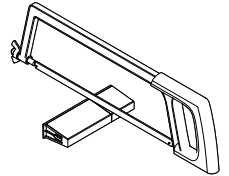
- ① Peel off the liners from the dual-lock strips.
- ② Slide the top trim into hinge pocket of appliance (A), and then engage dual lock at non-hinge side (B).

Re-installing flow divider

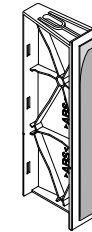
The flow divider blocks the air flow from bypassing in front of the bottom grille.

IMPORTANT!

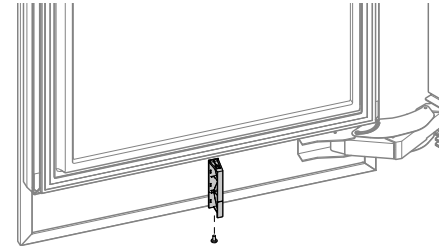
- For toe kick height greater than 102mm, shorten the air flow divider.
- Cut along the outline on both the divider and divider cover before installation to the door.
- Ensure to file the cut portions of the divider and cover.



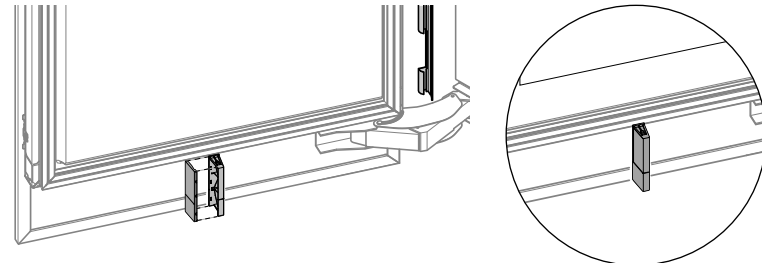
- ③ Remove adhesive layer off the flow divider.



- ④ Press flow divider firmly against door panel. Ensure adhesive layer contacts door panel. Screw in flow divider using same screw.



- ⑤ Attach flow divider cap to flow divider.

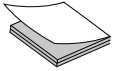

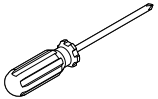


Cabinet side trim assembly

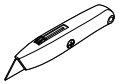

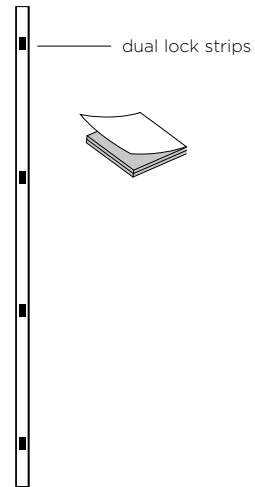

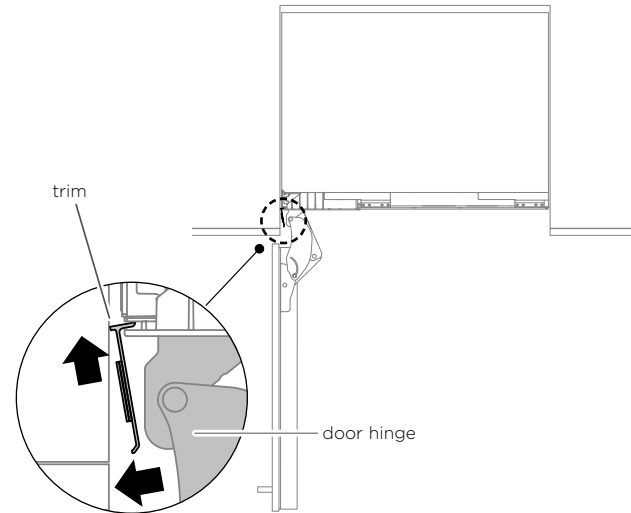

Installing side trims

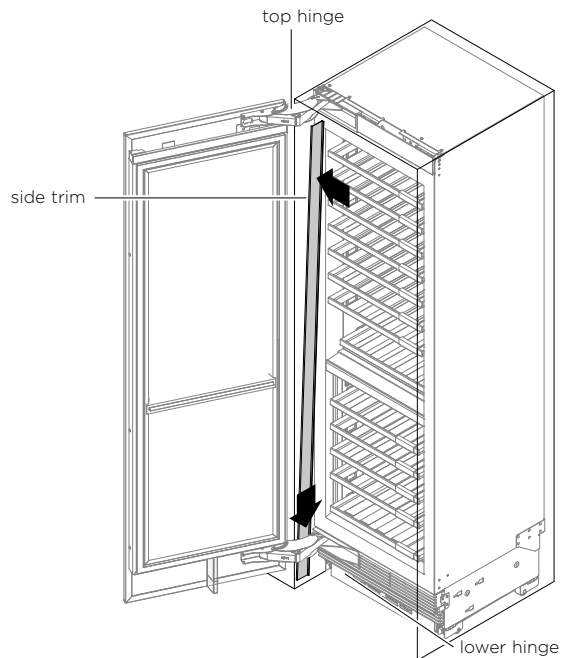
Four (4) dual-lock strips are pre-installed along each side trim.



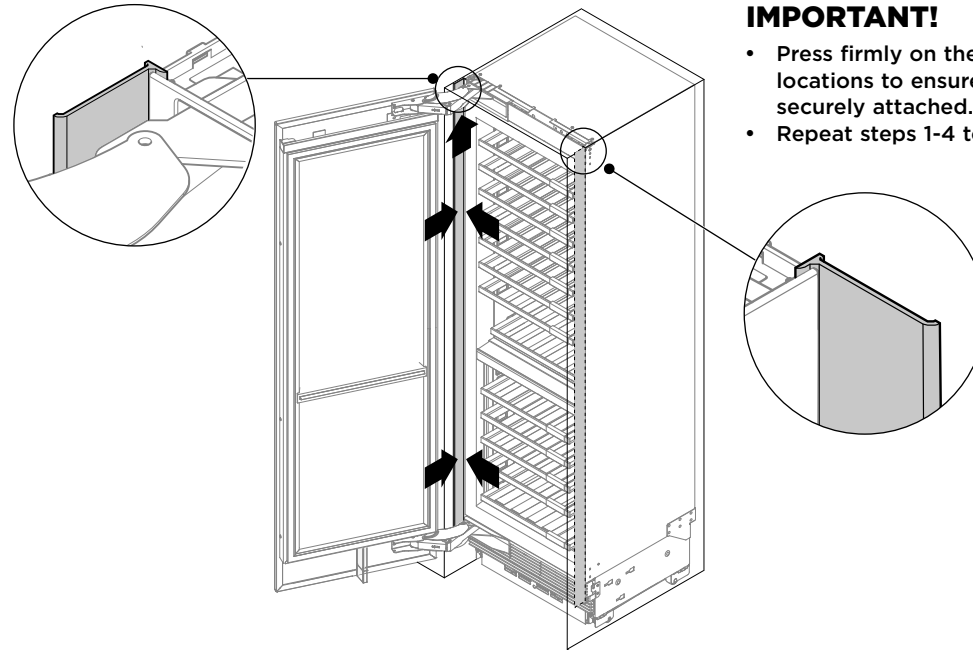
- ① Peel off the liners from the dual-lock strips.



- ② Position the trim on the throat at an angle.



- ③ Slide trim behind lower hinge, then top hinge. Hold the same angle when sliding the trim.



IMPORTANT!

- Press firmly on the dual-lock strip locations to ensure the side trims are securely attached.
- Repeat steps 1-4 to the other side trim.

- ④ Slot trim in behind top hinge pocket, then press adhesive to cavity ensuring trim is also tight against appliance inner face.

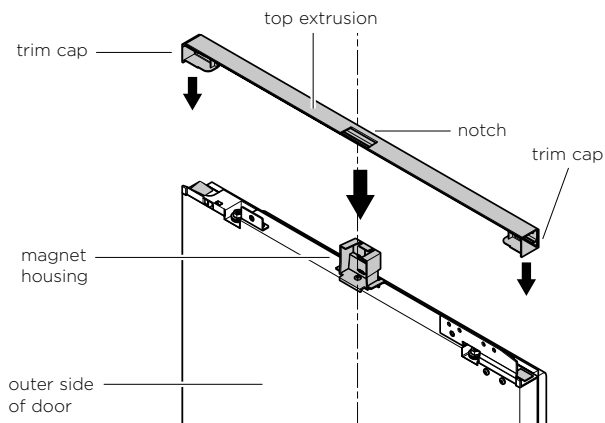

Door panel side extrusion (2)

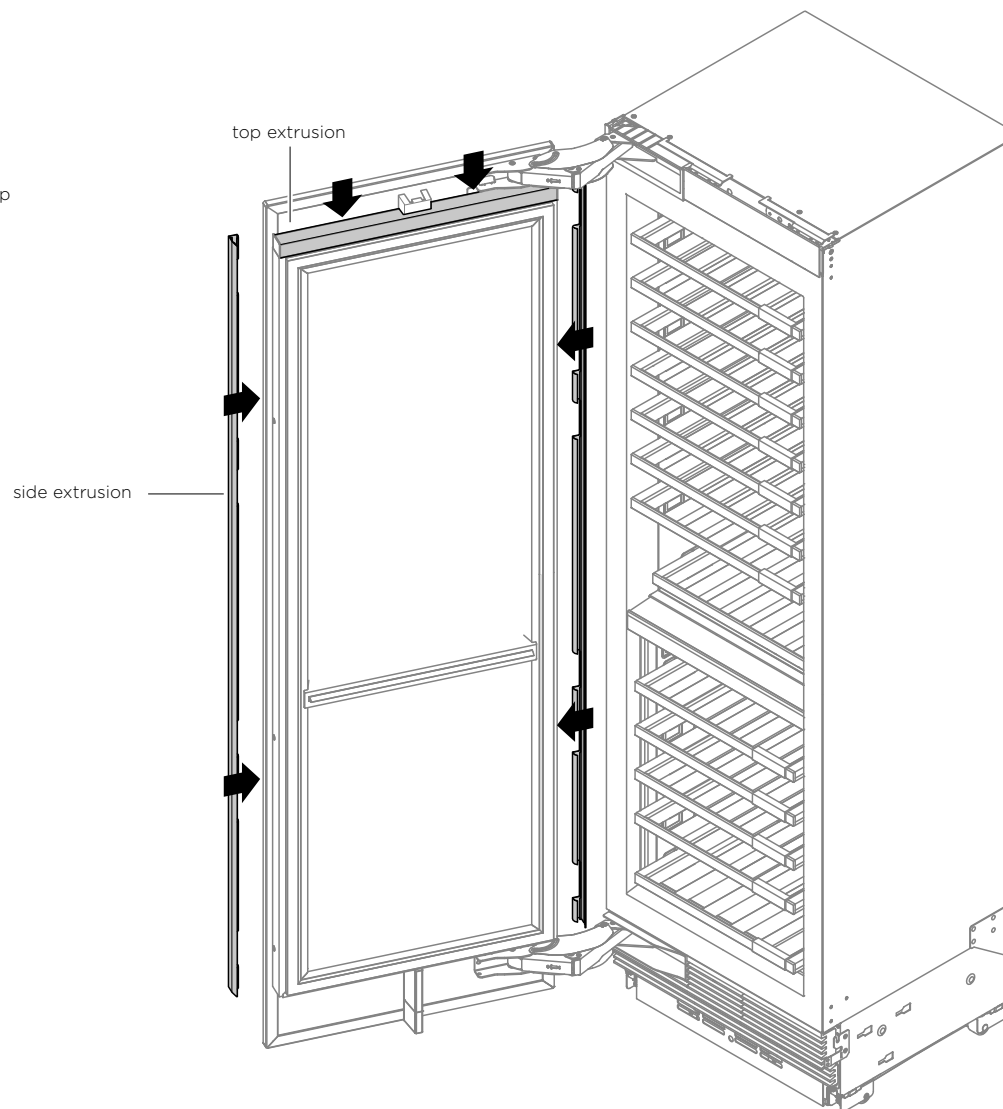
Installing door trims

- 1 Position door panel top extrusion to top of door. Align notch with magnet housing. Clip trim caps at both ends of top extrusion.



- 2 Peel off the liners from the dual-lock strips. Press top extrusion down so that dual lock strips engage each other.

- 3 Press side extrusions to fit into the right and left side gaps between door and door panel. Align top of side extrusions to fit with right and left ends of top extrusion.

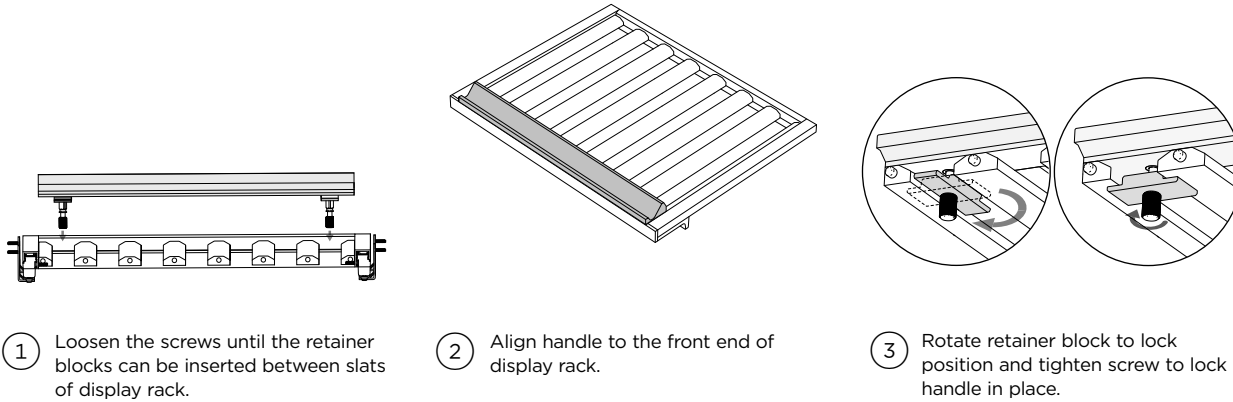


WINE DISPLAY

Installing wine display kit

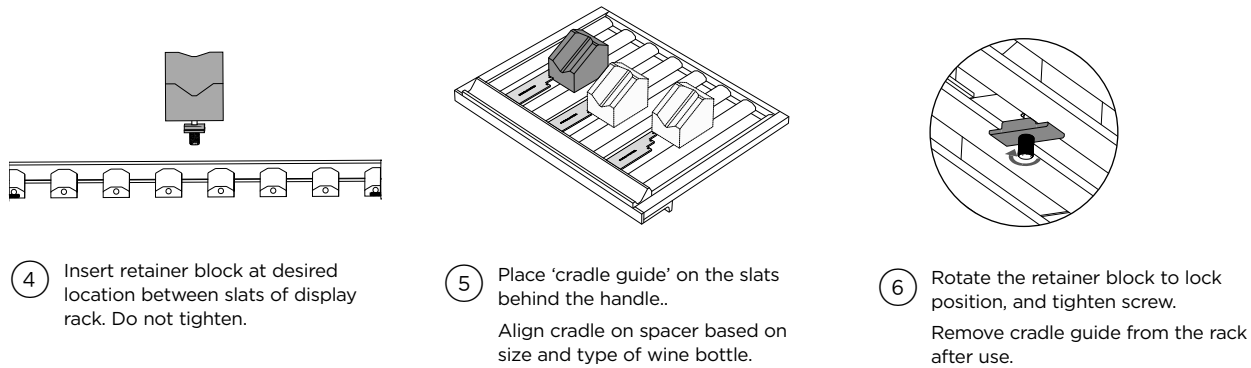
Handle assembly

Retainer blocks are pre-assembled at the bottom of both ends of the handle.



Cradle assembly

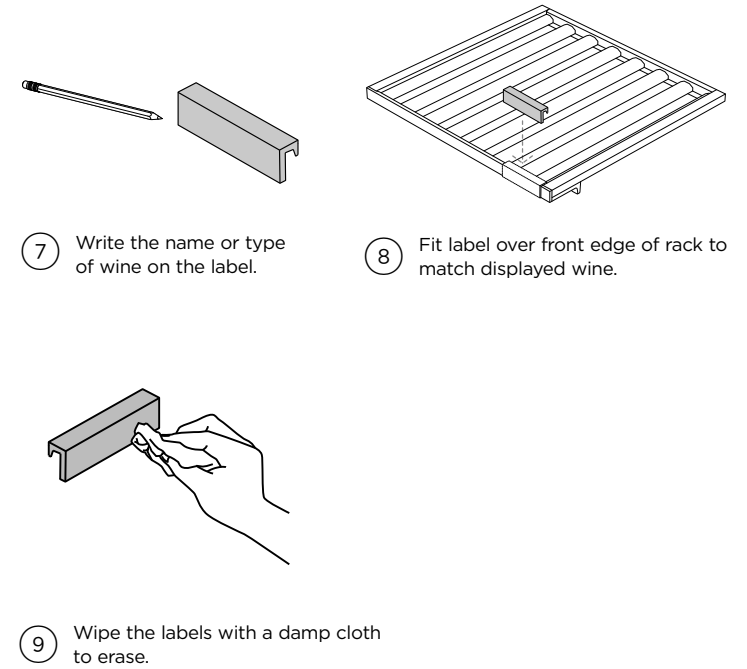
A retainer block is pre-assembled at the bottom of each cradle.



IMPORTANT!

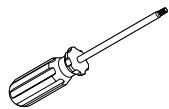
Use spacer to correctly position cradle and avoid wine bottles being too upright resulting in bottles tipping over.

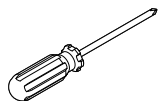

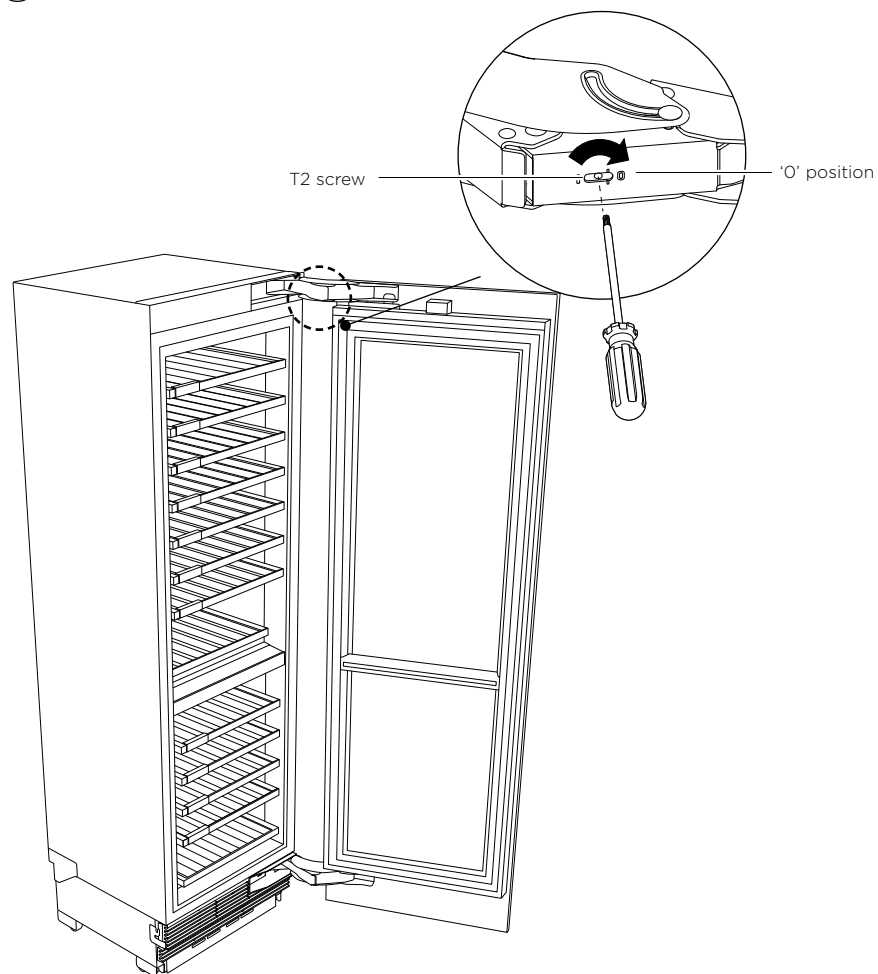


Hex key

You have the option to change the door hinge side of your appliance from right hand hinge to left hand hinge or vice versa. A hinge change kit is required for this installation, and must be purchased separately.

Removing the door

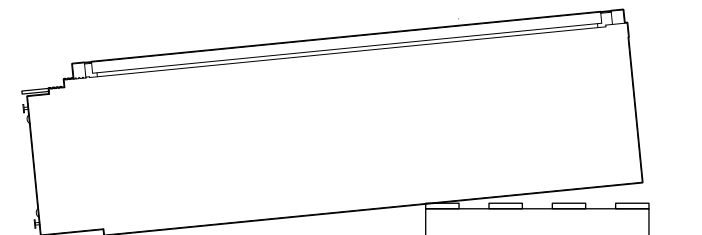
- 1 Release the hinge spring by turning the T2 screw in the hinge to '0' position.



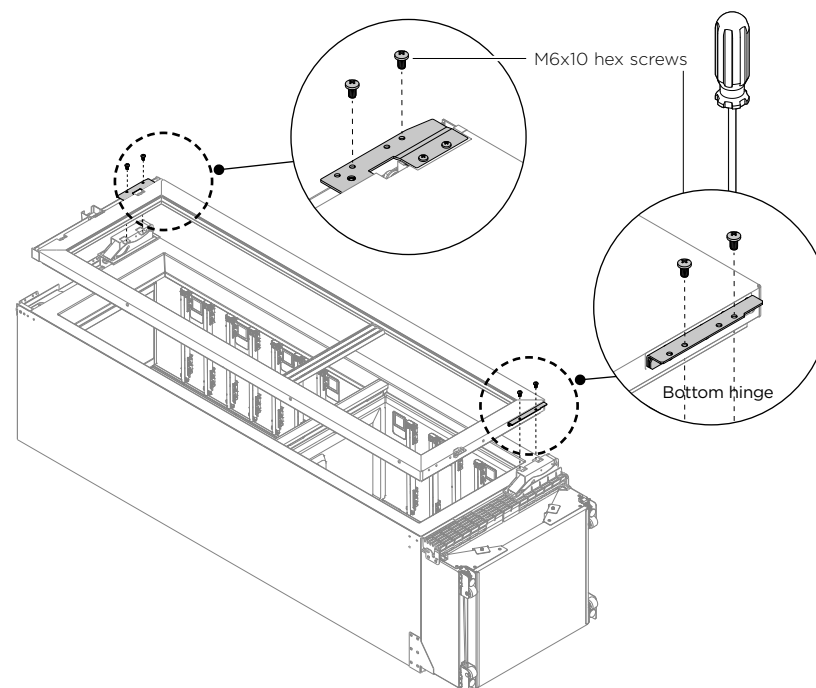
IMPORTANT!

- We recommend to lay the appliance (door closed) onto its back on the pallet when removing the door hinges.

- 2 Close the door and lay the appliance on its back on the pallet.



- 3 Detach the door from the appliance by unscrewing the door hinge M6x10 hex screws at the top and bottom hinges.

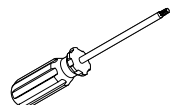


IMPORTANT!

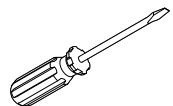
Ensure that you remove all the shelves, covers and trims from the appliance before changing the hinges. Take care not to damage the door.

Removing top door hinge

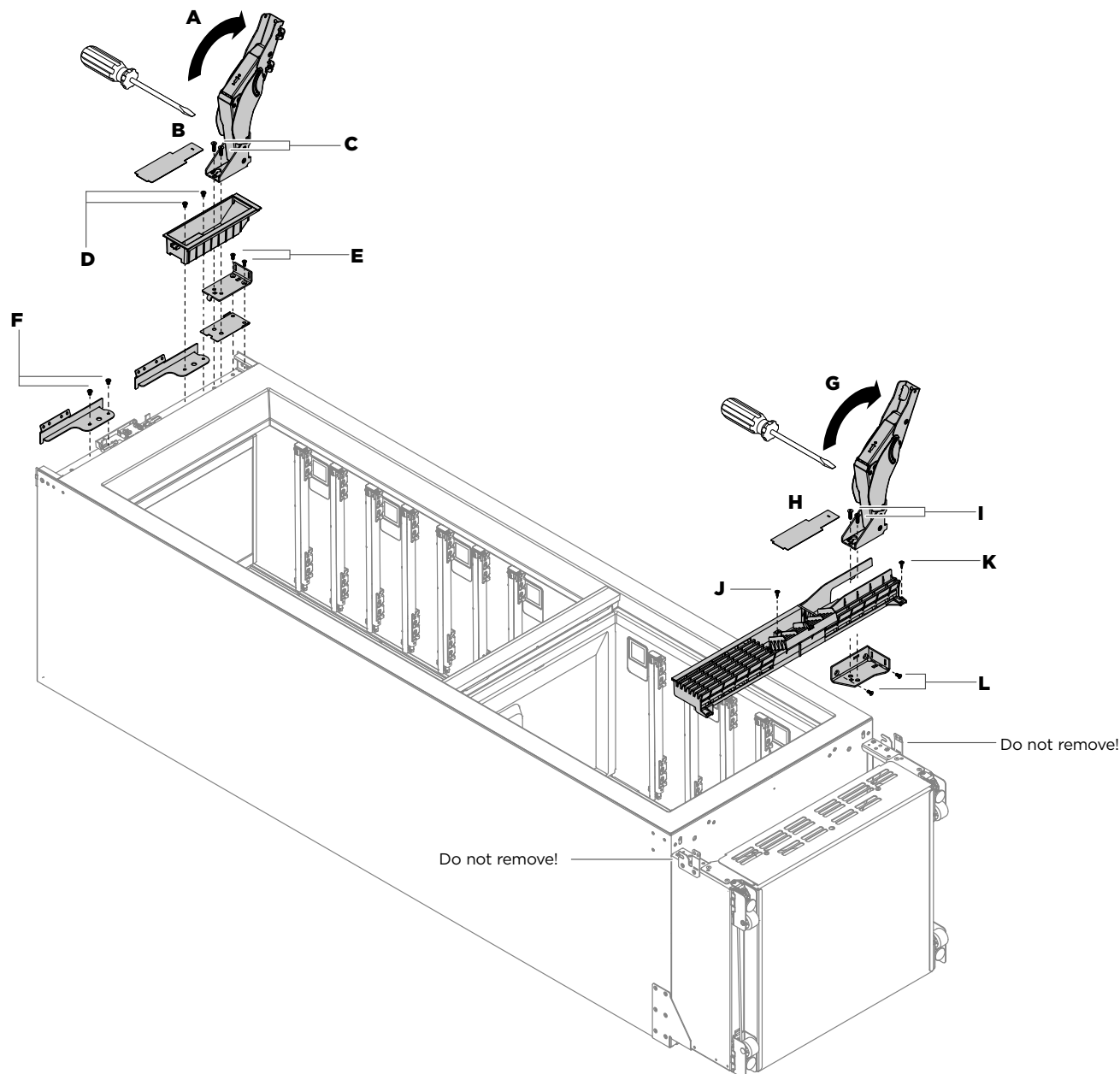
- ① Rotate the top hinge **(A)** outwards and remove the top hinge pocket cover **(B)** using the flat head screwdriver in the slot of the cover.
- ② Unscrew M5x12 pan head screws **(C)** to remove top hinge, and set aside to use later.
- ③ Unscrew M5x12 pan head screws **(D)** from hinge pocket to remove hinge pocket and top alcove bracket.
- ④ Unscrew M5x12 countersunk screws **(E)** to remove top hinge bracket and spacer.
- ⑤ For the non-hinge side, remove the top alcove bracket by unscrewing the M5x12 pan head screws **(F)**.

Removing bottom door hinge

- ⑥ Rotate the bottom hinge **(G)** outwards and remove bottom hinge pocket cover **(H)** using a flat head screwdriver in the slot.
- ⑦ Unscrew the M6x16 countersunk screws (2x) **(I)** to remove the hinge.
- ⑧ Open the water filter hatch on the bottom (fixed) grille and unscrew the #8x16 screw **(J)** while holding the grille in place.
- ⑨ Unscrew the #8x16 screws **(K)** from the bottom left and right of the bottom grille to remove the grille.
- ⑩ Unscrew M6x16 countersunk screws **(L)** to remove bottom hinge bracket.

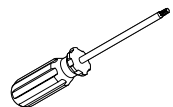
IMPORTANT!

retention brackets!**

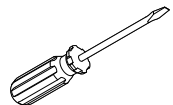

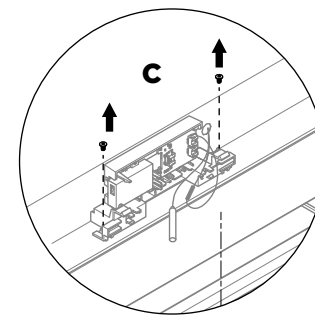
Moving the sensor housing



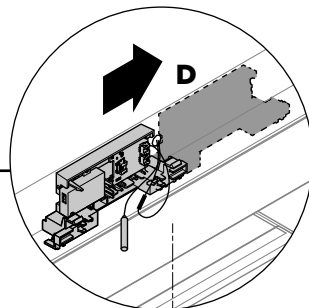
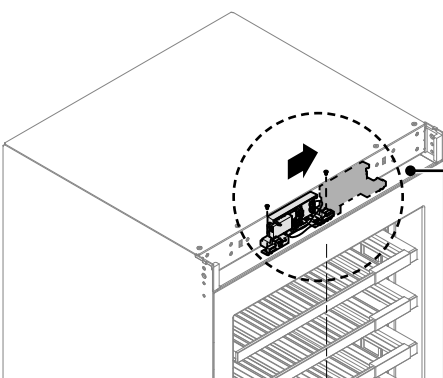
- ① Unclip the reed switch from the housing (A).



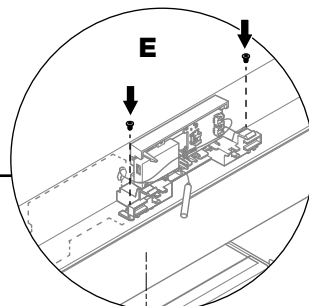
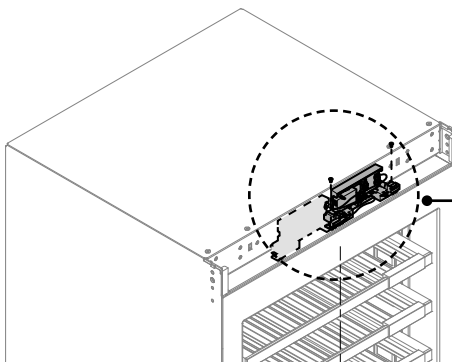
- ② Unhook the interceptor board harness from sensor housing so harness is loose (B).



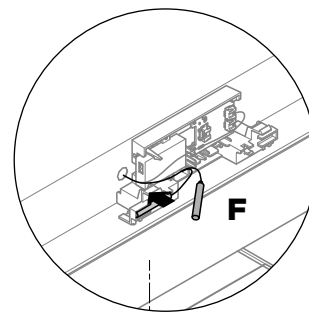
- ③ Remove the #8x16 screws (2x) from the sensor housing (C).



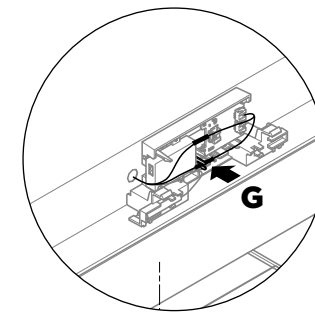
- ④ Move the sensor housing so that the opposite reed switch clip is aligned with the centre of the cabinet (D).



- ⑤ Reinstall the sensor housing using #8x16 screws (2x) into the pre-drilled holes in the cabinet top panel (E).



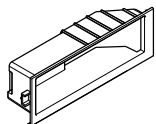
- ⑥ Clip the reed switch into the sensor housing in the pocket closest to the centreline of the cabinet (F).



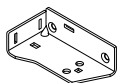
- ⑦ Press the harness from the interceptor board into the forks on the sensor housing (G).

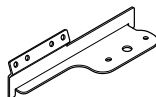
Hinge change assembly

top pocket (1)

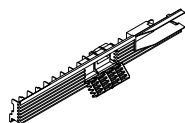


Lower (right or left)

Top (fixed) grille assembly



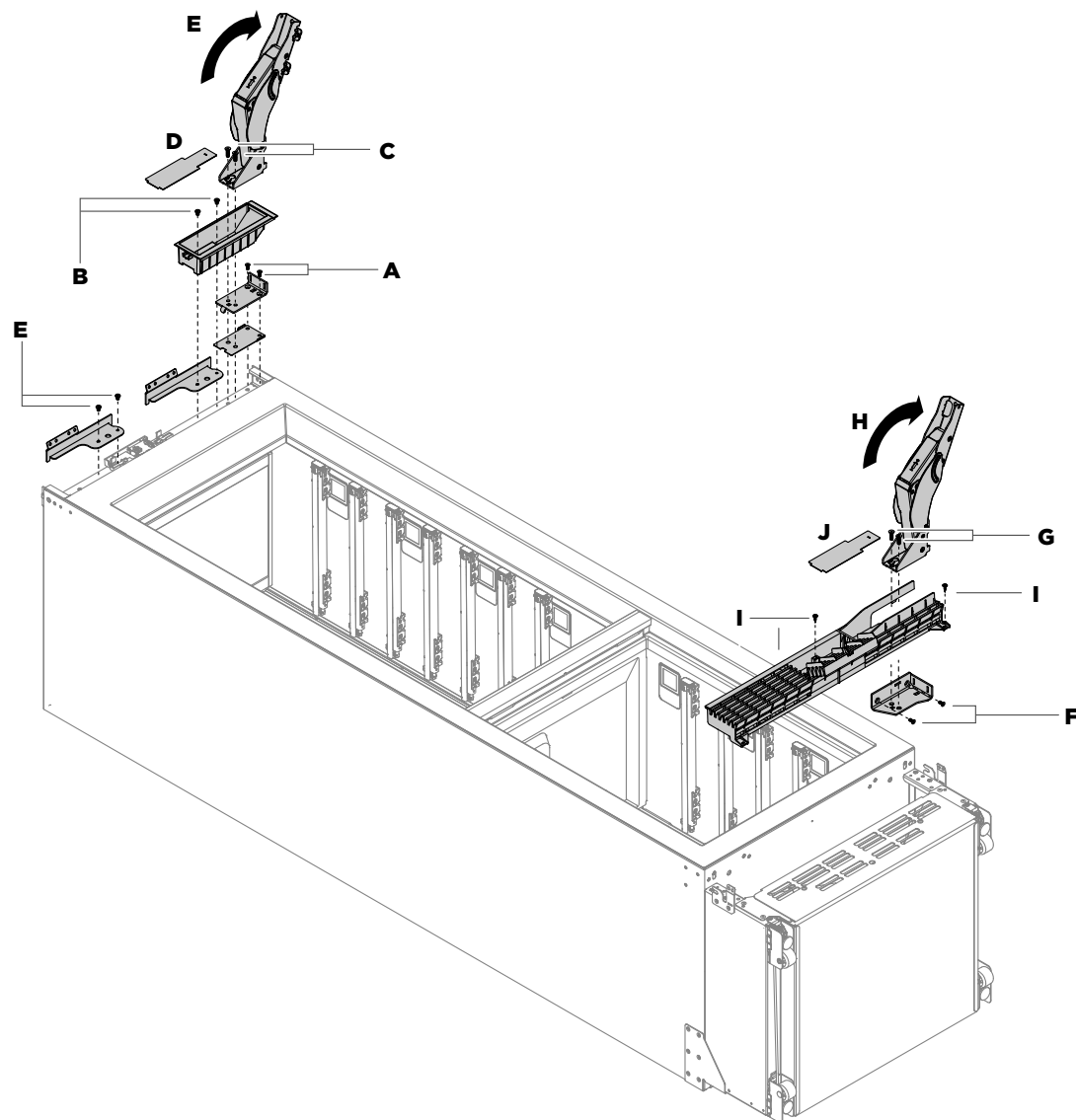

Top hinge installation

- ① Reinstall the hinge top bracket and bracket spacer with M5x12 countersunk screws (**A**) on the new hinge side at the other side of the appliance.
- ② Install the new hinge pocket and alcove top bracket on the new hinge side using two (2x) M5x12 pan head screws (**B**).
Note: The new hinge pocket and alcove top bracket are supplied with the hinge kit.
- ③ Install the new hinge in the new hinge pocket by screwing M5x12 pan head screws (2x) (**C**).
- ④ Open the hinge and reinstall the top hinge pocket cover (**D**) to the top hinge pocket.
- ⑤ Install a new alcove top bracket on the new non-hinge side (**E**).

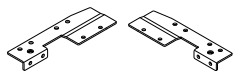
Bottom hinge installation

- ⑥ Install a new lower hinge bracket on the new hinge side with M6x16 screws (2x) (**F**).
- Ensure that the tab on the top of the bracket inserts into the slot in the plinth front bracket.
- ⑦ Use the hinge that was removed from the top of the appliance and insert the tabs into the hinge lower bracket. Rotate the hinge into place and fix with M5x12 countersunk screws (2x) (**G**).
- ⑧ Open the hinge (**H**), and install the new top (fixed) grille assembly.
- ⑨ Fasten in place with #8x16 screws (3x) (**I**). One each at the bottom left and right of the grille and one behind the water filter hatch.
- ⑩ Reinstall the bottom hinge pocket cover to the new hinge pocket (**J**).

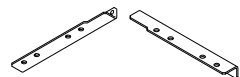

Hinge change assembly

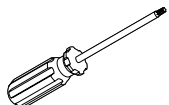


K05 top adaptor bracket R/L (1)

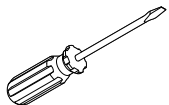


K05 bottom adaptor bracket R/L (1)

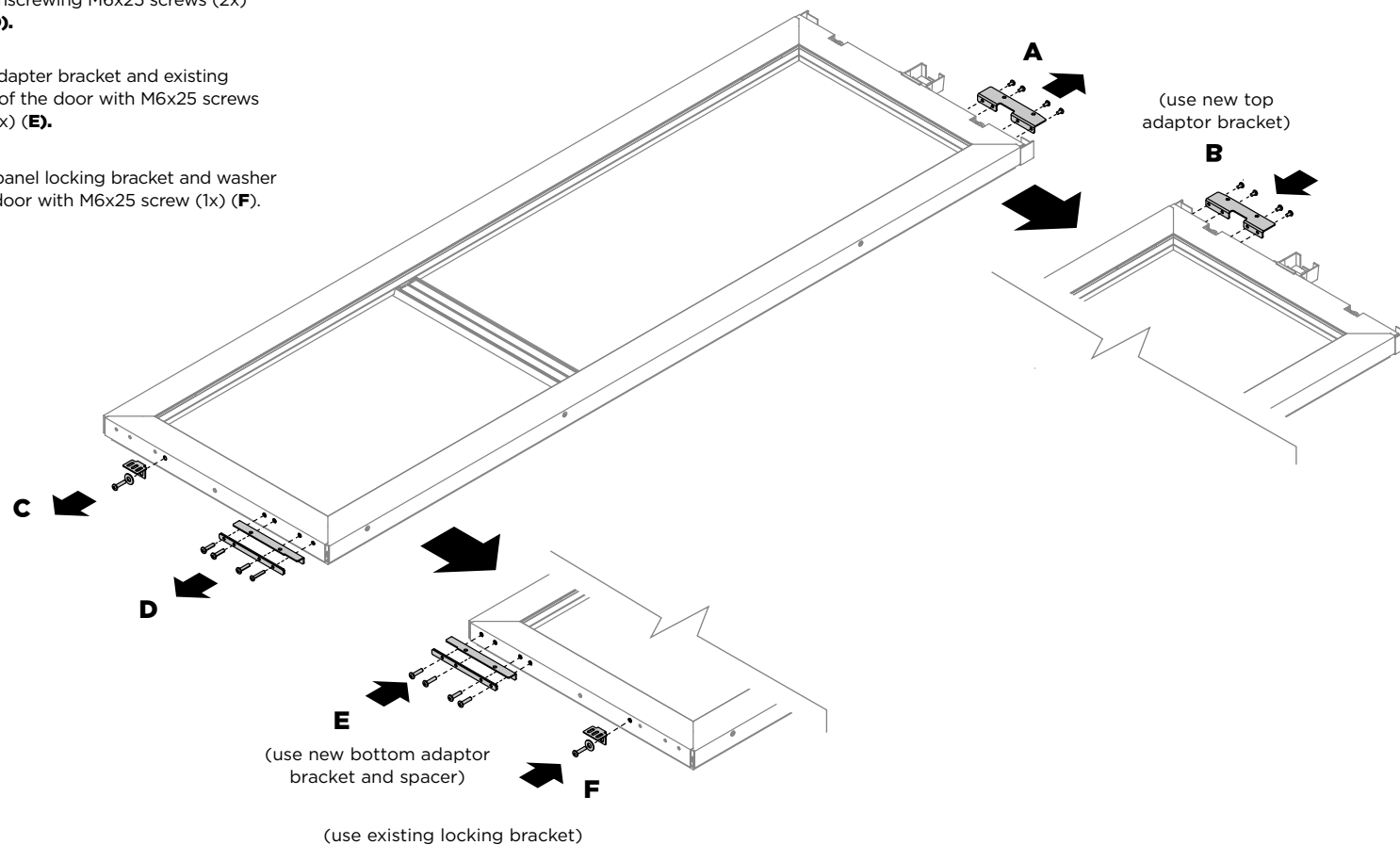

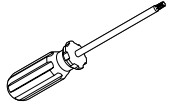
Door brackets

- ① Remove the top adapter bracket from the top of the door by unscrewing M5x10 screws (4x) **(A)**.
- ② Install the **new** top adapter bracket into the other side of the top of the door with M5x10 screws (4x) **(B)**.
- ③ Remove the door panel locking bracket and washer from the bottom of the door by unscrewing M6x25 screw (1x) **(C)**.
- ④ Remove the bottom adapter bracket and spacer from the bottom of the door by unscrewing M6x25 screws (2x) and M5x30 screw (1x) **(D)**.
- ⑤ Install the **new** bottom adapter bracket and existing spacer to the other side of the door with M6x25 screws (2x) and M5x30 screw (1x) **(E)**.
- ⑥ Install the existing door panel locking bracket and washer to the other side of the door with M6x25 screw (1x) **(F)**.

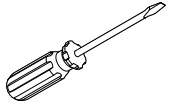

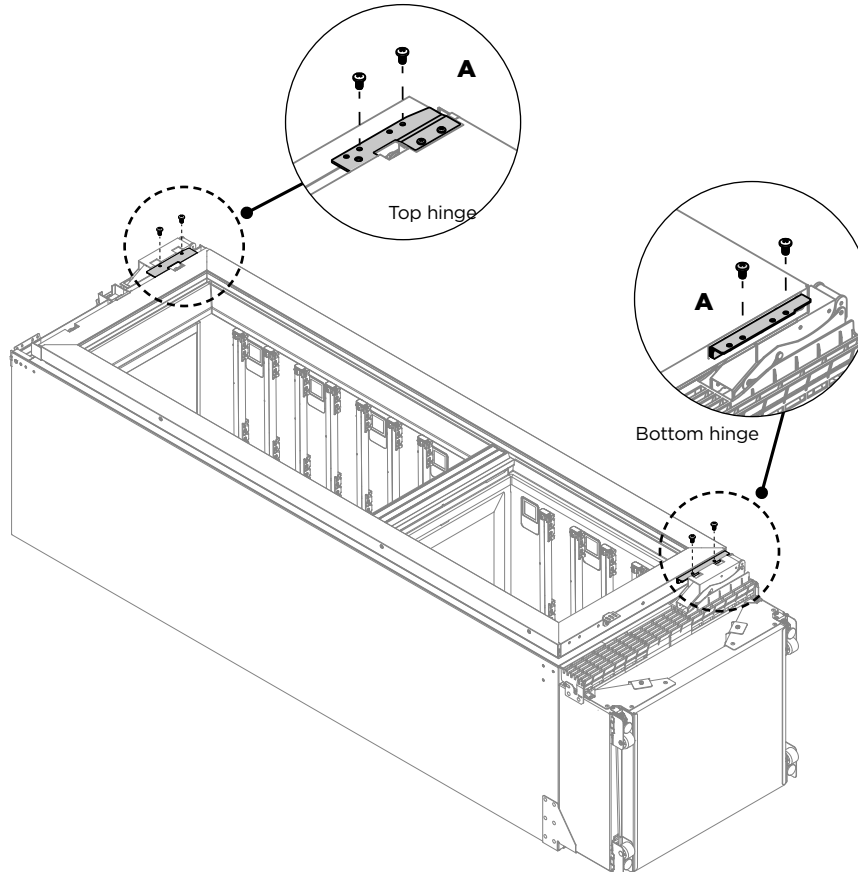

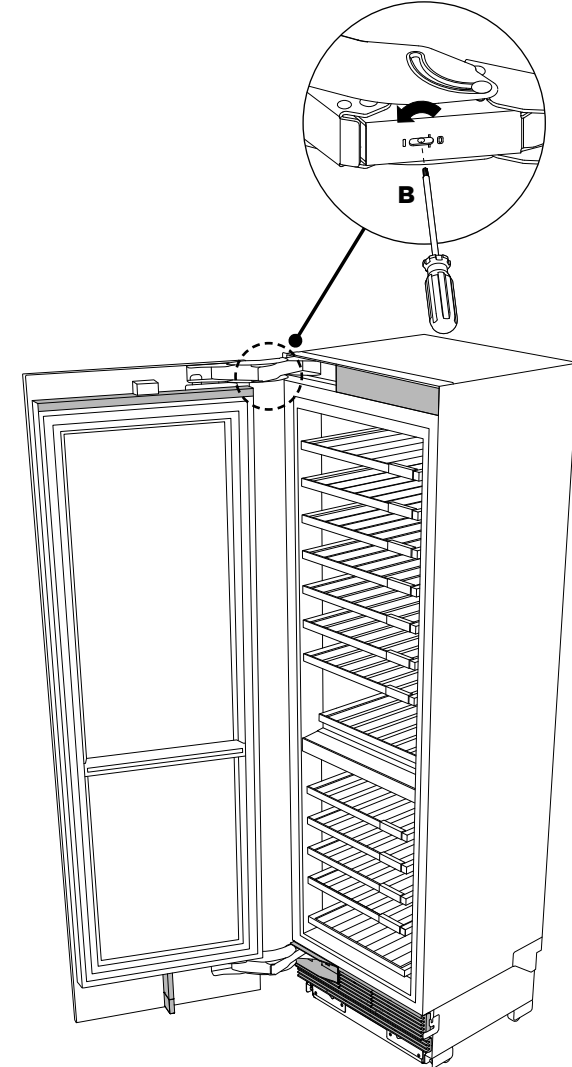

Door installation

- 1 Reinstall the door to the appliance using M6x10 hex screws (4x) into the hinges (**A**).



- 2 Activate the hinge spring by turning the star T20 screws to the I position (**B**).



- 3 Return the appliance to the upright position, and reinstall all covers and trims.

FINAL CHECKLIST



TO BE COMPLETED BY THE INSTALLER

All models

- ☐ Check all parts are installed.
- ☐ Ensure the appliance is level.
- ☐ Ensure the appliance is securely fastened to the cabinetry with the supplied anti-tip bracket and fittings.
- ☐ Ensure the door can open and close freely with no resistance from surrounding cabinetry.
- ☐ Ensure hinge limiting pin is fitted for 90° door swing.
- ☐ Ensure all internal and external packaging is removed from the appliance before use.
