Installation location


- This product is designed to sit on a firm, flat surface. Do
 not place the product on built-in installation such as a
 bookcase or rack because the ventilation slots around
 the product will be blocked, resulting in reduced lifetime
 from overheating. To assure adequate ventilation for this
 product, maintain a spacing of 20cm or more around the
 product.
- Make sure the product on the furniture is of adequate size and strength to prevent it from being accidentally tipped over, pushed off, or pulled off. This could cause personal injury and/or damage to the product.
- Installation of wall mount must be carried out by qualified personnel only. Incorrect assembly can result in severe personal injury and property damage (if you intend to install this product yourself, you must check for installations such as electrical wiring and plumbing that may be buried inside the wall). It is the installer's responsibility to verify that the wall will safely support the total load of the product and wall mount brackets.

Mount your Sound Bar main unit on the wall


You can choose to place your Sound Bar main unit below the center of your TV or mount it on the wall.




- Place the supplied wall mount template on the wall. Make sure the wall mount template is at least 10cm below the center of the TV.
- Use a level to make sure the Sound Bar is positioned accurately.
- Use the tape to stick the wall mount template firmly on the wall.
- 4. Mark on the wall using each marking on the template through the mounting holes.
- 5. Take away the wall mount template.
- 6. Drill a screw hole at each marking on the wall.



- Take out the screws from the rear of the soundbar, 2 per side
- Using a screwdriver, attach the mounting brackets to the soundbar.
- 9. Installation Complete




- Insert the supplied wall anchors into 2 screw holes on the wall.
- 11. Insert the supplied screws into the wall anchors.
- 12. Fix and tighten the screws on the wall.
- 13. Hang the Sound Bar main unit on the screws.



Product panel introduction

Button and jack definition:


There are 4 buttons; there are 8 jacks, which are defined as follows:



- 1. U: Press to power on, short press to switch function, long press to power off
- 2. -: Press for volume down
- 3. +: Press for volume up
- 4. 8: Press for Bluetooth pairing
- 5. MICRO SD
- 6. USB
- 7. DC IN: DC14V = 2A input
- 8. HDMI: HDMI ARC
- 9. LINE IN: 3.5mm connector
- 10. OPT: Optical input
- 11. AUX IN(R&L): For external audio input (RCA)

Function indicator light:

- 1. Red light: in standby mode
- 2. White light: in operation



Function of each button

- 1. U: Press to power on and power off
- 2. Press to switch to Bluetooth mode, long press to bluetooth pairing
- 3. LINE IN: Press to switch to LINE IN input
- 4. USB: Press to switch to USB play when insert USB
- 5. HDMI: Press to switch to HDMI mode

- 6. MUSIC: Press to select the MUSIC sound mode
- 7. MOVIE: Press to select the MOVIE sound mode
- TREBLE +: Press to increase treble sound (the white light flashes, when hit the maximum or minimum level white light will be on)
- TREBLE –: Press to decrease treble sound (the white light flashes, when hit the maximum or minimum level white light will be on)
- 10. BASS –: Press to decrease bass sound (the white light flashes, when hit the maximum or minimum level white light will be on)
- 11. I≼: Press to previous song under Bluetooth, USB or MICRO SD mode
- 12. MUTE: Press the mute button and turn on the sound button (white light will flash slowly when mute)
- 13. AUX: Press to switch to external AUX input
- 14. OPTICAL: Press to switch to the Optical input mode
- 15. MICRO SD: Press to MICRO SD play
- 16. NEWS: Press to select the NEWS sound mode
- 17. VOL +: Press or long press to increase volume (the white light flashes, when hit the maximum or minimum level white light will be on)
- BASS +: Press to increase bass (the white light flashes, when hit the maximum or minimum level white light will be on)
- YOL -: Press or long press to decrease volume (the white light flashes, when hit the maximum or minimum level white light will be on)
- 20. ▶: Press to next song under Bluetooth, USB or MICRO SD mode
- 21. ►II: Press to play or pause playing under Bluetooth, USB or MICRO SD

Get Started:

- Make sure you have made all the necessary cable connections before connecting the Soundbar to a wall outlet, the soundbar will enter to standby mode, the indicator will light up in red.
- Make sure the subwoofer is connected to the power, and turn the button to "ON"
- 3. Press "也" on unit or remote control to turn on the soundbar. The Bluetooth indicator will light up.
- Approximately 20 seconds after you have selected the mode (Bluetooth/USB/MICRO SD/Line in/Optical/Aux/HDMI), the LED indicator will turn off. When you press a function button on the remote control, the LED will turn back on again.

Operation instruction

Bluetooth Mode

- 1. Power on the Soundbar by pressing the "U" button.
- Press the "9" button on the unit or long press the "9" button on the Remote control, a voice will say "Bluetooth pairing". Keep distance between BT devices within 3 feet.
- Select "TCL TS3010" on the pairing list of Bluetooth device to pair. If your device requests a password, enter the default password 0000. Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on pairing and connecting Bluetooth devices.
- When successfully paired, a voice will announce, "Bluetooth device connected," and the LED indicator will turn solid white. Now BT device can play audio through the soundbar.

5. After initial pairing, anytime the Soundbar powers ON it will automatically connect to the previous Bluetooth device used. Note: If your device become unpaired or you find it is unable to connect, press & hold the "9" button (sound bar) to enter to Pairing Mode. A voice will announce, "Bluetooth device disconnected," and you can connect to the soundbar manually.

LINE IN Mode

After power on, connect the external audio sources to the LINE IN jack of soundbar by using the 3.5mm audio cable, and then Press the "O" button on the soundbar or the "LINE IN" button on the remote control to switch to "LINE IN" mode. At this time, music from the external audio sources such as MP3/CD can be played. (please adjust the volume of the external audio sources accordingly at a comfortable level.)

AUX IN Mode

After power on, connect external audio sources, such as CD/TV to the AUX in jack of the soundbar by using the RCA cable, and then Press the "O" button on the soundbar or the "AUX" button on the remote control to switch to "AUX IN" mode. At this time, music from the external audio sources can be played. (please adjust the volume of the external sound source accordingly at a comfortable level.)

HDMI ARC Mode

Press the "U" button on the soundbar or "HDMI" button on the remote control to switch to "HDMI ARC" mode. At this point, connect the HDMI cable to the TV set and then to the HDMI ARC jack on the back of the soundbar. Ensure the HDMI ARC function is activated on your. TV, and digital output is set to PCM.

OPTICAL Mode

Press the "U" button on the soundbar or "OPTICAL" button on the remote control to switch to "OPTICAL" mode. At this time, connect the DVD audio and equipment to Soundbar's OPT IN jack with the optical cable. This machine decodes optical fiber digital to restore sound through power amplifier.

Note: If there has the dust cover, remove it from the optical jack before you connect the optical cable. Ensure your TVs digital output is set to PCM.

USB Mode

After power on, insert the USB into the USB jack of the soundbar; the machine automatically goes to USB playback mode and plays the music in USB. Press the "▶ı" button to play and pause the music. Press "١◄" or "▶ı" button to select music up and down.

MICRO SD Mode

After power on, insert the MICRO SD card into the MICRO SD jack of the soundbar; the machine automatically goes to MICRO SD playback mode and plays the music in MICRO SD card. Press the "▶ıı" button to play and pause the music. Press "◄" or "▶ı" button to select music up and down.

Volume and Sound effect regulation

A. After power on, in any mode of playback, Press or long press the volume "-" button on the soundbar or remote control to lower the volume. Press or long press the volume "+" button on the soundbar or remote control to raise the volume.

Note: When the maximum or minimum volume is reached, the LED light will be on and a beep will be heard.

 B. After power on, in any mode of playback, Press the remote control to choose sound effect mode: MUSIC, MOVIE and NEWS

Note: The user can adjust each kind of sound effect mode to enjoy the music according to the personal preference!

Power off:

When the machine is power on, long press "U" button on soundbar or Press "U" button on remote control to power off, If the machine is unplugged from power supply, the machine will be completely powered off.

When the machine is power on, press "—" on the subwoofer back side to power off.

FAQ

Question	Answer approach
Bluetooth paired connection cannot be completed	Another mobile device may be connected to the soundbar. Disconnected the other connected bluetooth device. Once the device is disconnected, you device should pair automatically-provided it was previously paired.
Volume of Bluetooth playback is low	1. After connections with mobile devices, the volume of Bluetooth device is not up-but at the default output level. Turn up the mobile device volume. 2. Output volume of Bluetooth device is low itself.
Short Bluetooth connection distance	Obstruction exists between mobile devices and Bluetooth device. Remove obstructions.
Bluetooth connection plays normally, sometimes with broken sound.	Obstruction exists between mobile devices and Bluetooth device. Remove obstructions. Too far away from Bluetooth device to connected mobile devices, beyond the connection range. Shorten the distance between the Bluetooth device and mobile devices.

Subwoofer not working	Turn on the soundbar then press and hold both the button of Volume+ and Volume- for 3-5 seconds, then turn on the subwoofer, the red LED on Subwoofer will flash for 4 times. Plug off the AC adaptor from the soundbar, restart the device and complete the pair between the soundbar and subwoofer.	
Play no sound	Make sure you activate the PCM signal output on your TV or device when the HDMI ARC/Optical audio source is selected on the sound bar. For more information of how to activate the PCM signal output, check the user manual of your TV or device.
