INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT

- This TV Mount is capable of supporting TVs weighing 50kg maximum.
- This TV Mount suits TVs with a maximum mounting pattern of 410 x 505mm (height x width).
- Installation of this product will be easier if two people are involved.
- Some images in this guide may vary slightly from the actual components supplied.

WARRANTY

This Crest TV Mount carries a limited warranty of five (5) years from the date of purchase.

Crest, by this warranty, will at its discretion repair or replace the product or its components if found to be defective in workmanship or materials.

Where a warranty claim is made, Crest may require the customer at their expense to return the product and or its components to Crest or a Crest representative for inspection.

This limited warranty covers supply of the replacement product (which may vary from the one originally purchased) only and does not extend to, nor covers costs associated with, demounting, removal, disposal or return of the original product, or installation of the replacement product.

This limited warranty does not cover damage or loss resulting from intentional or unintentional misuse, tampering with, neglect or incorrect installation or use of this product or where the product has been used for purposes other than that for which it is designed or for supporting displays beyond the product's capability as stated on the product's original packaging and in this guide.

Failure to strictly comply with this installation guide may result in forfeiture of the warranty by the purchaser, user or owner.

Any warranty claim must be accompanied by proof of purchase showing date and location of purchase.

- 1. Ensure this Installation Guide is completely read and understood before attempting installation.
- Crest TV mounts MUST NOT be installed solely in plasterboard, fibre cement and similar surfaces.
- 3. Crest TV mounts MUST be installed in sound supporting structures such as those made of timber, steel or masonry using appropriate fasteners.
- 4. The supporting structure must be capable of sustaining the combined weight of the TV mount and the display otherwise the structure must be reinforced.
- 5. The fasteners supplied in this hardware pack allow for fixing into timber and masonry only. If installing into a supporting structure made of steel, appropriate fasteners must be used and sourced from an appropriate supplier.
- 6. Use appropriate tools and safety equipment and ensure adequate ventilation during installation.
- 7. If uncertain about any aspect of installation, contact Crest or an installation professional.


Drywall (Timber Frame) Installation

- Spirit level Phillips-head screwdriver
- PencilDrill

In addition, for Masonry Installation

- Drill with hammer function
- 10mm masonry drill bit
- Hammer

Warranty and Installation Guide Low Profile Fixed Flat Panel Mount

STEP 1 - ATTACH WALL PLATE TO WALL

A. Installing in Drywall (Timber frame)

- 1. Locate centre of timber studs using stud finder.
- 2. Mark a minimum of four fixing holes (one at top and bottom at either end of wall plate) over stud centres using wall plate as guide. Ensure plate is level.
- 3. Predrill holes to a depth of 60mm using 6mm drill bit.
- 4. Attach wall plate using lag bolts (Q) through washers (R). Do not over tighten. See Figure 1.

B. Installing in Masonry

- Mark a minimum of four fixing holes (one at top and bottom at either end of wall plate) using wall plate as guide. Ensure plate is level.
- Predrill holes to a depth of 65mm using 10mm masonry bit. Clean out holes.
- 3. Fully insert concrete anchors (P). Tap in with hammer if required. See Figure 2.
- Attach wall plate by inserting lag bolts (Q) through washers (R) into each concrete anchor and tighten.
 Do not over tighten. See Figure 3.

STEP 2 - ATTACH ARMS TO TV




Figure 5 – Use a longer bolt and spacer for displays with curved or recessed backs. Do not use washer (O) if using M8 bolts

Use correct bolt size and length (M4, M5, M6 or M8) with corresponding lock washers (C, F, I or L) to attach arms to rear of display. If using M4, M5 or M6 bolts also use washers (O). Use longer bolts and spacers (M or N) if rear of display is curved or recessed. See Figure 5. To avoid damaging your display, do not over tighten bolts.

STEP 3 – HOOK ARMS OVER WALL PLATE AND LOCK IN SAFETY BAR

- 1. With the assistance of another person, carefully lift TV and hook arms over wall plate. See Figure 6.
- 2. Insert safety bar and install padlock (not supplied) to prevent theft. See Figure 7.
